**Dear all,** Candlemas beautifully continues the light first given to us at our Baptism. On that day, a candle was lit from the Paschal Candle and entrusted to us with the words, "Receive the light of Christ." It was a sign that Christ's light now shines in our lives, calling us to live as children of the light.

At Candlemas, as we bless and carry candles once more, we are reminded that this baptismal light has not faded with time. Instead, it is meant to grow stronger as we walk with Christ. ## The Feast of Encounter

In 2014, Pope Francis, who as a Jesuit was a consecrated priest, spoke of the Presentation of the Lord as "the feast of Encounter." The Gospels recall the encounter between Jesus and his people, when Mary and Joseph brought their child to the Temple in Jerusalem; the first encounter between Jesus and his people, represented by Simeon and Anna, took place. The Pope also noted that it was also an encounter "between the young and the old." The young were Mary and Joseph who brought their infant son to the Temple in accordance with the Law of Moses; the old were Simeon and Anna who waited patiently and full of hope for "a light for revelation to the Gentiles and the glory of your people Israel" as the antiphon for the Mass says. Pope Francis described the Presentation as the unique encounter between observance and prophecy, where the young are the observers and the old are the prophets. He continued: "In fact, if we think carefully, observance of the Law is animated by the Spirit and the prophecy moves forward along the path traced by the Law." He spoke of Consecrated life as the encounter between these two elements, between the young and the old, between observation and prophecy. There is no rivalry or opposition between these realities. Instead, the Holy Spirit animates them both, so that they become signs of joy that can be recognised by all. His words spoken to consecrated persons are also important for us to hear. He concluded by saying: "It's good for the elderly to communicate their wisdom to the young; and it's good for the young people to gather this wealth of experience and wisdom, and to carry it forward, not so as to safeguard it in a museum, but to carry it forward addressing the challenges that life brings." May the grace of this mystery, the mystery of the Encounter, enlighten us and comfort us on our journey. Amen. **Fr John**
