October: the month of the Rosary

This month is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. The Rosary became popular in medieval times as a devotion to the important moments in the lives of Jesus and his mother, Mary.

According to an account by fifteenth-century Dominican, Alan de la Roch, Mary appeared to

St Dominic in 1206 after he had been praying and doing severe penances because of his lack of success in combating the Albigensian heresy. Mary praised him for his valiant fight against the heretics and then gave him the Rosary as a mighty weapon, explained its uses and efficacy, and told him to preach it to others. In 1571, St. Pius V attributed the great defeat of the Turkish fleet at Lepanto on the first Sunday of October to the fact that at the same time the Rosary confraternities at Rome and elsewhere were holding their processions. He later wrote that "by Mary's intercession before the throne of God, she did not cease to pour forth prayers and supplication for the safety of her people."

October includes the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (7 Oct.), an important patron around the world, including the Diocesan shrine in Cardona, Philippines; Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral in Jashpur, India (second largest church in Asia); and the sanctuary of Fátima, Portugal. Speaking at the Wednesday General Audience, Pope Leo invited Catholics to pray the Rosary every day during October "I invite everyone," each day of the coming month, to pray the Rosary for peace—personally, in the family, and in community."

This month why not take part in (or even host) the parish 'Rosary at Home,' when we meet in each other's home during October to pray the Rosary. More information, including sign-up sheets, can be found on the noticeboard in the narthex. See you there! Fr John
