ADVENT – CHRISTMAS

This is the time of the year when we begin to receive Christmas cards. One of the popular scenes is that of the Annunciation. We're familiar with Mary's response to the

Angel Gabriel's momentous announcement to the young girl: 'Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word.' (Luke 1:38) Mary said yes to the invitation to be the Mother of God. It is understandable that many artists have depicted the scene in beautiful works of art.

I'm sure you will have noticed the picture in the narthex. The young Mary is often painted kneeling with an angel hovering over her delivering a message. In our picture we see a young angel holding out a hand to a young girl. The angel is delivering a message. The message is the most important message ever given. The young girl and the angel face each other. Mary is in deep thought and prayer; she stretches out her hand in acceptance. Before she accepts to be the Mother of God, St Luke records that she was greatly troubled. She was greatly troubled and didn't understand what was happening, but she made a great act of faith and responded with those momentous words, 'Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word.' She accepted the invitation to be the Mother of God and did so with faith and love. Mary's reply was given not once but repeatedly as Jesus' earthly life unfolded. It was a mirror to Jesus' yes to his Father. In his earthly life we see how he listened to the Father in his moments of prayer and then acted.


